The Challenge



To restore years of erosion, siltation, and vegetative growth in order to:

1. **Improve** storm drainage.
2. **Restore** the creek's beauty.
3. **Protect** the environment, water quality, plant life, and wildlife habitat.

Our planning team is working with the City of St. Albert to implement restoration plans in the spring of 2011.

This project is a partnership that involves our community taking on a leadership role plan to implement the work required, with the support of the City.

The Opportunities



The proposal involves the following ideas so far...

- Removal of clay and debris from the creek's channel.
- Installing a new liner and creek bed rock base.
- Adding rock to the creek banks.
- Adding large rocks and boulders to the creek banks and bed.
- Planting new vegetation to beautify the area and help to purify the water.
- Installing a recirculating water system to maintain creek flow.
