Community Projects Update

Levasseur Dog Park

A dog park was originally scheduled to be constructed in the fall of 2010, under the high voltage power lines parallel to Levasseur Road, between 170 Street and Hudson Road. Construction of the park has been delayed because the land owner, AltaLink, needs to increase the capacity of their power lines to handle growing electricity consumption. AltaLink expects their work on the lines will be completed by the end of 2011, after which the City will seek final approval from AltaLink to rezone the property to parkland. Construction contracts will be awarded after the rezoning has been passed by City Council, which means the time frame for completion of the dog park is now some time in 2012.

Heritage Lake South Creek Restoration Project

The HLCA is working with a group of residents called the Heritage Lake South West Creek Restoration Committee, who want to complete the rehabilitation of the creek that flows into the south end of Heritage Lakes. On behalf of the Committee, the HLCA is applying for several grants to fund the project, which currently has a budget of over \$100,000. Volunteer labour comprises over \$18,000 of the budget, and the City of St. Albert has already approved a grant of \$19,000. Several City departments are working closely with the Committee to ensure that the rehabilitation plan is in accordance with City regulations and standards, and that the work is done by qualified contractors. Work will not commence until all of the funding is in place, which will not happen until early in 2012. Signatures of support have been collected from residents on adjacent streets, which helps in the grant application process. The Committee expects to be ready to start work next spring, as soon as weather and soil conditions permit.

2011 Sports Night
