Community Projects Update

Levasseur Dog Park

AltaLink is currently in the process of increasing the capacity of their power lines to handle growing electricity consumption. AltaLink expects their work on the lines will be completed this spring. The City of St. Albert now expects the time frame for completion of the dog park to be Fall 2012.

Heritage Lake SW Creek Restoration Update

We are pleased to inform you that the Heritage Lake SW Creek Restoration Committee, a sub-committee of the HLCA, has been successful in obtaining two funding grants, one from the City of St. Albert, and one from the Province, towards restoration of the SW creek that flows into the Heritage Lake Pond. As a result, local residents can watch for the project to resume after the snow has melted and the ground is dry. The initial priority will be excavating, re-grading, and re-rocking the creek from behind #51 Howard Crescent west and north to the top of the waterfall, before the creek enters the Heritage Lake Pond.

This project is a joint partnership between the volunteer HLCA Board, the volunteer Heritage Lake SW Creek Restoration Committee comprised of local residents, many additional volunteer local residents, and the City of St. Albert. Unanimous support has been expressed to date regarding this project from all local residents.
